

The SRS asks traders shipping from China to Amazon, Temu, AliExpress and other distance selling platforms to take advantage of the programmatic interface for data submission

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In order to optimise the organisational processes of companies and facilitate faster customs clearance, the State Revenue Service (SRS) invites economic operators (carriers, traders providing services for customs clearance) to take advantage of the software interface of the Electronic Customs Data Processing System (EMDAS) for the submission of customs declarations, i.e. to use the system-to-system solution for the submission of data on goods on the distance selling platform. Submission of data in this format will allow traders to avoid manual transcription errors and will also significantly speed up the time taken to prepare and process declarations.
